The assessment process is, necessarily, largely subjective in nature.

Any candidate who is deemed to be deficient in any aspect of assessment will have their application shelved, will be notified of the reason(s), and be invited to continue the application when they have gained the required experience and/or level of competence.

Any applicant who feels that their application was unjustifiably shelved may file an appeal using this form.
